

State of Massachusetts Opens FY25 Round of Community One Stop for Growth Grant Program

The State of Massachusetts recently announced that the FY25 round of the Community One Stop for Growth is now open. The **Community One Stop for Growth** is a single application portal and collaborative review process of community development grant programs that make targeted investments based on a Development Continuum. To apply for funding through the Community One Stop for Growth, applicants must complete and submit a Full Application through the **IGX system**.

For the FY25 Round, twelve (12) programs will be administered through the Community One Stop for Growth with a single application portal to access programs offered by the Executive Office of Economic Development, Executive Office of Housing and Livable Communities, and MassDevelopment.

The Expression of Interest is open through **April 30, 2024.** The Full Application **closes on June 5, 2024.**
